Personal specification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outgoing with good communication skills • Likes people • Horticultural experiences or good plant knowledge desirable but not essential • Ability to follow instructions • Flexible • Team player • A sense of humour • Self-motivated • Ability to complete routine and repetitive tasks to a high standard • Willingness to 'get hands dirty'
What we offer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training relevant to the role • Uniform (deposit required) • Travel expenses, up to £5 per day • Personal protective equipment where required
Please note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The role can be physically demanding so a good level of fitness is required • There is no public transport to or from Banham Zoo so your own transport is essential • Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age • Volunteering is not the same as a work experience placement • Whilst volunteers are free to apply for jobs if they become available volunteering does not guarantee you a job
